

Standards and Expectations

At all times, pupils are expected to:

- be polite, behave well and follow instructions at all times, in school and in the local community
- respect the environment
- respect each other
- be polite
- move quietly and sensibly around school
- do as you are asked first time.

Uniform

Footwear should be plain black shoes, business-style with leather uppers and black socks.



Large bows or coloured accessories and logos are not permitted. Be aware that some retailers call their training shoes 'school shoes'.

If it looks like a trainer, it is a trainer and will not be permitted.

Outdoor coats should be removed when on site.

Blazer, school tie and house badge should be worn at all times.



Only school badges awarded by LDA may be worn on the blazer.

Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

School pinafores must be knee-length.

Jewellery and make-up

Pupils are **not allowed** to wear any jewellery other than a watch.

No piercings of any kind are allowed.

Make-up, nail varnish, false eye-lashes and false nails are **not allowed**.

Semi-permanent make-up and false tan are **not allowed**.

Drinks, chewing gum and litter

Pupils may bring still water on site and can drink it throughout the day.

Bottles should not exceed 750ml.

Before school, at break and lunch times, pupils can purchase healthy drinks from the school canteen.

No chewing gum.

Pupils must not drop litter or leave it for others to clear away.



Haircuts, facial hair and hair accessories

Extreme haircuts (eg: shaved no.1) and colouring, which is in stark contrast to natural tones is **not allowed**.

Full head shave: minimum no.3

No. 1 on sides only.

Boys must be clean shaven; facial hair is **not allowed**.

Hair below the shoulder or excessive must be securely tied back. Hair should be secured out of the eyes or cut above eye level.

Hair accessories, including religious accessories, must be in school colours only and small in size. Items with glitter, flowers, slogans or other adornments are **not allowed**.

Mobile phones and electronic devices (including smart watches)

Mobile phones are a banned item and are **not permitted**.

If you need to bring your mobile phone to school, you must hand it in to Student Services at the start of the day.

Mobile phones found in school will be confiscated and returned only to parents / carers at a pre-arranged time.

If parents / carers need to contact you in an emergency, they can contact Student Services.



Attendance and Punctuality

All pupils should aim for 100% attendance.

All pupils should be on time at the start of the day and to all lessons.

Holidays will not be authorised during term-time.
