LDA COVID TESTING CENTRE

LDA continues to support pupils and staff with on-site Covid Testing in our 'Testing Centre' and pupils were given 3 weeks supply of 'Test Kits' just before the Easter break. Pupils should take the Covid Lateral Flow test 2x a week (between 3 and 4 days apart). These kits will be given to pupils every 2 to 3 weeks.

Reporting Pupil Test Results:

It is important that Parents report each test result of their child's Lateral Flow Test **to both NHS Track and Trace AND Lord Derby Academy.**

Reporting Pupil Test Results:

1. Scan each QR code (opposite) to access NHS and LDA Reporting Sites (you may need to download a QR reader to your phone)
2. Scan the QR code on the lateral flow device when asked by NHS (just copy or type this code into the LDA Reporting Form)
3. It may be helpful to set up an NHS 'account' with a username and password to avoid having to repeat adding all of your details each time you report a test


