






This week's Numeracy puzzle...

Physical Education

KS3 PE

Key Stage 3 pupils have had a very positive start to the new academic year and PE staff are happy with the progress that has been made during the first half term.

This half term, classes across KS3 are enjoying Fitness, Volleyball and Football. We are also offering a whole host of PE enrichment activities, before and after school. PE enrichment timetables are displayed in the main atrium as well as the PE area.

Year 10 GCSE PE pupils have made a very positive start to their studies. They have begun by learning about physical training and have carried out a series of fitness tests across a range of the components of fitness including the multistage fitness test and the sit and reach test. We will soon begin to use this data to start the Performance Analysis coursework part of the course which involves pupils identifying their strengths and weaknesses then designing a training programme around their findings.

If your child misses a lesson due to illness etc then they can catch up by using the Year 10 lesson materials contained in the Year 10 GCSE PE Google classroom. Homework is given out every week.

Year 11 GCSE PE pupils have made a very positive start to their studies this year. They have begun Y11 by learning about sports psychology and anatomy and physiology. They will soon be sitting their Y11 mock exams and this time will sit a Paper1 and a Paper 2 on Friday 2nd December and Friday 9th December so that the mock exam process emulates the real thing. In preparation for this, extra lessons are running on Friday between 3:00pm and 3:50pm.

It also important that Y11 devote time to develop their practical scores, they can do this by attending the relevant clubs within school:

> Tuesday to Friday 8:00am - Basketball Tuesday lunch – Volleyball Tuesday 3.00 - 4:00pm - Netball Wednesday 3:00-4:00pm - Trampolining Friday lunch - Table Tennis Friday 4:00-5.00pm - Football

SPORTS STUDIES

Year 11 pupils are currently studying Contemporary Issues in Sport ready for their official examination in January 2023. They have been learning about the issues that affect participation in sports. For Year 11, our mock exam has been scheduled by your teacher so make sure you are fully prepared. Year 10 pupils have had a great start to their course. They are currently studying the Performance and Sports Leadership module and are making excellent progress with their first assignment. They have been learning about the importance of health and safety when planning their own coaching session. Their next assignment is to plan their own sports session, where pupils are expected to create a detailed session plan. The pupils are then assessed on their delivery of their session. Year 10 pupils have also begun to develop their practical scores in table tennis.

If your child misses a lesson due to illness etc then they can catch via Google classroom. On Google classroom they will find PowerPoint presentations and Year 11 additional resources, such as exam questions and past papers. Pupils can also request extra help/guidance by messaging their Sports Studies teacher.

So far this year Yr7,10 & 11 have all taken part in the Knowsley Netball Tournaments and played extremely well. Stand out performances came from N. Morrison Yr10, A. Harvey Yr7 and A. Lopez Yr11. Training is on every Tuesday 3.00pm to 4.00pm and all pupils are welcome. We are hoping to play more Netball matches against other local schools in the near future.

Merseyside finals.




University of Liverpool Maths School Trip

The pupils completed a day of activities, investigating the use of simultaneous equations and the forming of parabola curves, particularly how they link to projectile motions and resultant forces.
