Year 7 pupils have made an excellent start to their food journey at LDA. They have been looking at food safety and kitchen hazards so they will be fully prepared for their first practical lesson, fruit fusion.

Year 8 pupils are looking at food from other cultures, they have been researching suitable bread recipes and even got to taste some focaccia bread.

Year 9 have looked at food standards in the UK and considering the factors that ensure food is of the necessary quality. Pupils are now investigating how these standards apply to chilled ready meals.

Design & Technology Year 7 pupils have started developing their design skills and are learning about technical drawing. Look out for homework to practise their isometric and crating drawing skills! Homework will be on the MCAS app.










In Design & Technology Year 8 pupils have been developing their analysis and evaluation skills by disassembling products to identify the inner components and discover how they work. They have then been introduced programming using Crumble kits. Learning about inputs, processes and outputs.

In Food & Nutrition Year 10, Mrs Hampson and Miss Brown would like to congratulate pupils on their encouraging start to GCSE food, preparation and nutrition. Pupils are currently studying fruit & vegetables and food spoilage. Pupils will explore how fruit and vegetables are used within sweet and savoury dishes to create flavour, texture and colour. Food spoilage is a key topic this term to enable pupils to gain understanding of how pathogenic bacteria affects food and why prevention is key when storing, preparing and cooking food.
